This privacy notice sets out how we use and look after the personal information we collect from you. We take reasonable care to keep your personal information secure and to prevent any unauthorized access to or use of it.

Personal data is any information about an individual from which that individual can be identified.

You provide this information when signing your children up to clubs/camps/teams etc.

We collect and store some of this data.

As well as details such as phone number, email address, contact details and gender we also ask for details of medical conditions/allergies for the purpose of welfare, health and safeguarding. This is always given with consent of the parent/guardian.

1. Why do we need personal data?

We will only use it for the purpose it has been provided for.

Examples are:

Players/participants forms and payments – performance of a contract

Sharing data with managers, coaches and club officials – performance of a contract

Sharing data to provide information about future camps/courses/events – maintaining participant correspondence with consent.

To ensure we are aware of and understand possible health risks – consent – we will only process details on your medical history with your consent.

Personal data retention – will be kept for no longer than is necessary. Personal data will be disposed of securely when no longer needed in order to prevent it becoming inaccurate or irrelevant.

2. Who we share personal data with

Coaches, managers and club officials if needed.

3. Protection of your personal data

Security measures in place to prevent data being lost, altered or used in an unauthorized way.

We will take reasonable measures to destroy or delete data which is no longer required.

4. Your rights re personal data

You are not obliged to share your personal data with HS Sports but this would maybe prevent your child from being registered on one of our camps/clubs/courses.

You have the right at any time to request access to your data, restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your data.

5. Photo consent

On joining HS Sports a consent form will be signed if you agree to your child being in photographs within HS Sports training, matches or events . These may be used for publication, social media, advertisement or display.

If consent is withdrawn we will take reasonable steps to remove images however it is not always possible to recall all images that have been published.
